The Baptist's Corner - Eternal Security

As we go out and witness to folks about what Jesus Christ did for us and our need to believe on His death, burial and resurrection, in order to be saved from eternal damnation, we will find many people who do not understand the doctrine of eternal security. Many of those who do proclaim to believe in the Gospel of Jesus Christ as their means of salvation are not convinced their salvation is forever guaranteed. They believe they must work to maintain their salvation. Friends, just as we are not able to earn our salvation when we are lost, we are not able to earn

our damnation once we are saved! Scripture backs us up on this statement. We have talked previously about what establishes our salvation, so we will go onto the point that our salvation is eternal. John 3:14-15 is a great place to start.

14 And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of man be lifted up:

15 That whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have eternal life.

Here God's Word promises us that whosoever believes in Jesus shall

not perish, but have eternal life. This is because Jesus was lifted up. He was nailed to the Cross, died, was buried and rose again all according to Scripture to pay for our sins. Verse 15 specifies this produces eternal life when we believe on Him. There are no other conditions applied here. John 3:16, a very famous verse, continues this statement,

16 For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

HB 176 Passed In Ohio

According to Voice of the Martyrs (www.persecution.com) Christians make up about 7.25% of China, 28.5% are of a folk religion and 49.58% are of a non-religious or other

Security

Verse 16 not only reiterates what verse 15 said about eternal life, but gives us the reason why this gift is given to us. We receive eternal life not because we have earned it, but because God so loved us! Once again, though, the key word here is eternal. It does not say life until we do something to lose our salvation.

John 6:37-38 has this to say,

37 All that the Father giveth me shall come to me; and him that cometh to me I will in no wise cast out.

38 For I came down from heaven, not to do mine own will, but the will of him that sent me.

This is Jesus speaking. Jesus promises us that all the Father gives him, he will in no wise cast out! We are with Jesus and once we believe on Him

for salvation, we remain his forever! Verse 38 tells us he does this because he is only doing the will of God the Father. It is the Father which sent the Son to die for the sins of the world because He loved the world so much. Let's look at verses 39 and 40 in John chapter 6,

39 And this is the Father's will which hath sent me, that of all which he hath given me I should lose nothing, but should raise it up again at the last day.

40 And this is the will of him that sent me, that every one which seeth the Son, and believeth on him, may have everlasting life: and I will raise him up at the last day.

Jesus will be raising us up on that last day because it is the

will of the Father that none should perish. All who believe on the name of Jesus for salvation will in no wise be cast out!

John 10:27-29 sums up this whole question perfectly!

27 My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me:

28 And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand.

29 My Father, which gave them me, is greater than all; and no man is able to pluck them out of my Father's hand.

Jesus tells us we are eternally saved. God's will is that we have eternal life. If God said it, that settles it!
