For anyone who has gone out to spread the Gospel of Jesus Christ knows, the thoughts surrounding what it takes to be saved varies greatly. How can this be so? Unfortunately, many people have wrongly understood what it takes to be saved because they have listened to their friends, a TV or radio preacher, a host of denominational churches, etc., but have not gone to see what God's Word says about what it takes to be saved. Paul warned the church of Gala-

tia about this and warned them that if anyone brings any other Gospel, other than what Paul had already brought, let them be accursed. There are many churches, groups, individuals that have been cursed because they are bringing a false gospel.

The gospel message is wonderfully presented to the church at Corinth in 1 Corinthians 15:1-4,

“1 Moreover, brethren, I declare unto you the gospel which I preached unto you,

which also ye have received, and wherein ye stand; 2 By which also ye are saved, if ye keep in memory what I preached unto you, unless ye have believed in vain. 3 For I delivered unto you first of all that which I also received, how that Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures; 4 And that he was buried, and that he rose again the third day according to the scriptures.”

individuals actually become hostile and attempt to use intimidation to force others to agree with their views and/or opinions. Many of these folks will distort the information in order to deceive.

Again, Al Gore's, "An Inconvenient Truth," and his testimony in front of the Senate on global warming demonstrate BOTH of these appalling tactics.

The bottom line is that as Christians, we are to desire truth. We are to deal in fact and we are to be reasonable. We must reject efforts to be intimidated and refrain from the temptation to intimidate. Believers desire information and seek to share information.

That should be the way we ROLL.

Intimidation vs. Information

As Bible Believers, we are to be "children of light." Light shines and the truth is known. As 1 Thessalonians 5:5 says, "Ye are all the children of light, and the children of the day: we are not of the night, nor of darkness."

But the world walks in darkness as they choose to walk without the light of God's word and the light that is given by the Spirit of God in our lives. What's worse is that many of the children of darkness seem to take up their darkness as a CRUSADE.

Take global warming as an example. Has there been global warming? Yes. Is it caused by man? Hardly. The science shows that the sun is the culprit for the warming and cooling that we are experiencing. It's been going on since the beginning of Creation and, according to God, it will continue that way until after the Rapture.

It is really appalling to see the way people act on emotion instead of education. What makes this worse is the fact that so many of these emotion-based

Paul makes it perfectly clear that it is Jesus Christ who died for us, was buried and rose again. We are saved by believing this message.

Some will have you believe you must earn salvation. If you think about, this is an impossible task. We are finite beings and we have sinned against an infinite God. The price for sin can never be paid in a finite amount of time. It is impossible for sin to exist with God, therefore there needs to be an infinite payment for sin. This could only be accomplished by God himself. Scripture specifies however that we are not

Ephesians 2:8, 9

9 Not of works, lest any man should boast.

Titus 3:5

5 Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost;

It just does not get any clearer than that. It is impossible for us to earn our salvation.

God understands we are not able to save ourselves. He loved us so much that He sent his only begotten Son, that whosoever believes on him will not perish but have everlasting life. See John 3:16.

I'm Saved, Now What?

When you believe the Gospel of Jesus Christ, you have been saved. That is, when you believe that Jesus' death on the Cross, that he was buried, and that he rose from the dead three days later as payment for your sin, you are saved. By faith you have believed this. God loved you enough to have His only begotten son pay the price of sin that we would otherwise had to pay ourselves. Everyone of us deserves to be dead and paying for our sin in hell at this very moment. Thankfully, God is merciful, gracious, and longsuffering.

But, you say, I believe that, but now what? Scripture is clear concerning our responsibilities after we have been saved. Once you believe, you should first of all be baptized. It is by baptism, full immersion baptism, that we announce to the world that we have believed on Jesus vicarious atonement for our sin. When we are fully immersed in the water of

baptism, we are showing that we are buried with Christ. By this we show that we believe we will also be resurrected bodily when Jesus comes back for his church.

Once we have been saved and have been baptized, we are to get busy! It is best to belong to a local fellowship that is centered around the Word of God as presented in the King James Bible. By doing this, we surround ourselves with other believers. We are to be separated from the world. The saying goes, "we are living in the world, but not part of the world." We have to live here, but we do not have to agree with the world's ways.

By being part of a local fellowship, we not only surround ourselves with other believers, but we can take advantage of the opportunity to learn from the Word of God under the watchful eye of our pastor and those who the pastor has entrusted to teaching of God's Word. We are also

to go out and preach the Gospel to others so they have the same opportunity we have. We are the planters of the seed of the Gospel and God will bring about the increase because a seed has been planted.

So, follow God's plan of church growth and plant those seeds.

Read Matthew 28:18 - 20 and study it,

18 And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth.

19 Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost:

20 Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world. Amen.
